CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR ADDITIONAL CANDIDATES TO SERVE ON THE NORTH WEST PROVINCIAL LANGUAGE COMMITTEE (NWPLC) IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 8(8)(a) OF THE PAN SOUTH AFRICAN LANGUAGE ACT NO 59 OF 1995 AS AMENDED.

The Member of the Executive of Council (MEC) for the Department of Arts, Culture, Sports and Recreation (ACSR) in consultation with the Pan South African Languages Board (PanSALB) hereby calls for application for additional candidates to serve on the North West Provincial Language Committee (NWPLC). Candidates must be a speaker of one of the official languages or have an expertise in the languages recognised by section 6(5) (b) of the Constitution mentioned below.

The term of the North West Provincial Committee is five (5) years from the date of appointment by the responsible MEC or the board of PanSALB.

Candidates

1. Must be first language speakers or users and have an extensive knowledge of the following languages of the province, have an interest in the development and use of the constitutionally recognised languages, be a South African citizen, and reside in the North West province.
 - 1.1. IsiXhosa
 - 1.2. Sesotho
 - 1.3. South African Sign Language
 - 1.4. The Khoe and San languages
 - 1.5. Religious and Heritage languages, and
 - 1.6. At least one member of the Provincial Language Committee shall be
 - (a) an officer in the department responsible for the basic education in the curriculum development;
 - (b) a member of the House of Traditional Leaders in the relevant province; and
 - (c) a member of the South African Broadcasting Corporation from the language development or similar unit.
2. Have a passion for and contribution to language development by advising on the following fields:
 - 2.1 Translation and interpreting, specifically of the language matters of the province, and including the establishment, compilation, and maintenance of relevant database
 - 2.2 Language status planning and language legislation formulation, implementation, and monitoring;
 - 2.3 Lexicography and terminology development;
 - 2.4 Conducting research in language matters; and/or
 - 2.5 Monitoring linguistic human rights matters in the province (legal knowledge will be an advantage).
3. Must provide the following required documents:
 - 3.1 A certified copy of South African Identity Document (ID);
 - 3.2 Certified copies of all authentic, relevant qualifications in the field of language and research;
 - 3.3 An abridged curriculum vitae; and
 - 3.4 Application form, completed in full. The form can be downloaded from the ACSR website or requested directly from the department of ACSR or PanSALB NW Provincial Offices.
